NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 94th plenary meeting of its thirty-fifth session, on 12 December 1980, the General Assembly adopted resolution 35/154, entitled "Conclusion of an international convention on the strengthening of the security of non-nuclear-weapon States against the use or threat of use of nuclear weapons".* In paragraph 6 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"<u>Recommends</u> that the Security Council should examine declarations which may be made by nuclear States regarding the strengthening of security guarantees for non-nuclear States and, if all these declarations are found consistent with the above-mentioned objective, should adopt an appropriate resolution approving them".
