#### I. INTRODUCTION

##### Opening and duration of the session

1. The second session of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee for the Elaboration of an International Convention to Combat Desertification in those Countries Experiencing Serious Drought and/or Desertification, particularly in Africa, was held in Geneva from 13 to 24 September 1993. The session was convened in accordance with paragraph 4 of General Assembly resolution 47/188 of 22 December 1992 entitled "Establishment of an intergovernmental negotiating committee for the elaboration of an international convention to combat desertification in those countries experiencing serious drought and/or desertification, particularly in Africa". At its second session, the Committee held \_\_\_ meetings (1st to \_\_\_).

#### II. ORGANIZATIONAL MATTERS

##### A. Election of officers

2. At the 2nd meeting, on 14 September, the Committee elected by acclamation Mr. Nikita F. Glazovsky (Russian Federation) as Rapporteur of the Committee to replace Mr. Sergei N. Morozov (Russian Federation), who was unable to continue his functions on the Bureau.

3. At the same meeting, the Committee also elected by acclamation Ms. Anne De Lattre (France) as Chairman of Working Group II to replace Mr. Jacques Alliot (France), who was unable to continue his functions on the Bureau.

4. At the 3rd meeting, on 20 September 1993, the Committee elected by acclamation Mr. A. Ovchinnikov (Uzbekistan) as Vice-Chairman-cum-Rapporteur of Working Group I.

C. Participation of intergovernmental organizations in the work of the Committee

At the 3rd meeting, on 20 September, the Committee, bearing in mind the provisions of General Assembly resolution 47/188 on the participation of observers in the work of the Committee in accordance with the established practice of the General Assembly, decided to accord observer status in its work to the intergovernmental organizations listed in document A/AC.241/L.5/Add.1\* and 2.
