The Permanent Mission of the Netherlands to the United Nations has the honour to communicate that the Netherlands is in a position to provide the United Nations Assistance Mission for Rwanda (UNAMIR) with the following equipment from the supplies of the Netherlands Armed Forces:

- (a) 50 all-wheel-drive trucks (4-ton);
- (b) 25 Landrovers;
- (c) 15 generators;
- (d) 10 kitchen trailers;
- (e) 2 ambulances (Landrovers);
- (f) 2 workshop vans;
- (g) 15 cargo trailers;
- (h) 16 mine detectors;
- (i) Approximately 100 Zambian personnel will receive training.

The Netherlands Government hopes that this contribution will help UNAMIR to implement the mandate entrusted to it by the Security Council.
