NOTE

The resolutions and decisions of the Economic and Social Council are identified as follows:

Resolutions

Until 1977 (up to and including the resumed sixty-third session), the resolutions of the Economic and Social Council were numbered consecutively and were identified by an arabic numeral followed by an indication of the session in parentheses (for example: resolution 1733 (LIV), resolution 1915 (ORG-75), resolution 2046 (S-III), adopted at the fifty-fourth session, the organizational session for 1975 and the third special session, respectively). When several resolutions were adopted under the same number, each of them was identified by a capital letter (for example: resolution 1926 B (LVIII), resolutions 1954 A to D (LIX)). The last resolution so numbered is resolution 2130 (LXIII), of 14 December 1977.

Since 1978, as part of the new system adopted for symbols of Council documents, the resolutions are numbered on a yearly basis and are identified by two arabic numerals separated by an oblique stroke, the first numeral indicating the year, the second the number of the resolution in the annual series (for example: resolution 1978/36).

Decisions

Until 1973 (up to and including the resumed fifty-fifth session), the decisions of the Council were not numbered. From 1974 to 1977 (up to and including

the resumed sixty-third session), the decisions were numbered consecutively and were identified by an arabic numeral followed by an indication of the session in parentheses (for example: decision 64 (ORG-75), decision 78 (LVIII), adopted at the organizational session for 1975 and the fifty-eighth session, respectively). The last decision so numbered is decision 293 (LXIII), of 2 December 1977.

Since 1978, as part of the new system adopted for symbols of Council documents, the decisions are identified by two arabic numerals separated by an oblique stroke, the first numeral indicating the year, the second the number of the decision in the series (for example: decision 1980/150).

The resolutions and decisions adopted by the Council in 1980 are published in three supplements to the *Official Records of the Economic and Social Council, 1980*, as follows:

Supplement No. 1 (organizational session for 1980 and first regular session of 1980);

Supplement No. 1A (second regular session of 1980);

Supplement No. 1B (resumed second regular session of 1980).

1980/188. Calendar of conferences and meetings

At its 46th plenary meeting, on 7 November 1980, the Council approved the extension by one week of the twelfth session of the Intergovernmental Working Group on a Code of Conduct, which will be held at United Nations Headquarters from 5 to 23 January 1981.

1980/189. Report of the Sixth United Nations Congress on the Prevention of Crime and the Treatment of Offenders

At its 46th plenary meeting, on 7 November 1980, the Council took note of the report of the Sixth United Nations Congress on the Prevention of Crime and the Treatment of Offenders¹ and transmitted it to the General Assembly for consideration at its thirty-fifth session.

1980/190. Examination of long-term trends in economic development

At its 46th plenary meeting, on 7 November 1980, the Council:

(a) Took note of the report of the Secretary-General on the preparation of an over-all socio-economic perspective of the development of the world economy,² prepared in accordance with General As-

sembly resolution 34/57 of 29 November 1979, and transmitted it to the Assembly for consideration at its thirty-fifth session:

(b) Requested the Secretary-General, when preparing the report to be submitted to the General Assembly at its thirty-sixth session, in compliance with the provisions of Assembly resolution 34/57, to take into consideration the working paper on long-term trends in economic development,³ as well as the views expressed at the resumed second regular session of 1980 of the Economic and Social Council and the thirty-fifth session of the General Assembly.

1980/191. Nomination of members of the World Food Council

At its 46th plenary meeting, on 7 November 1980, the Council decided to nominate the following States for election by the General Assembly, at its thirty-fifth session, to membership in the World Food Council for a three-year term:

(a) *African States* (three vacancies): Egypt, Rwanda and Zaire;

(b) *Asian States* (three vacancies): Indonesia, Japan and Pakistan;

(c) *Latin American States* (two vacancies): Argentina and Haiti;

(d) *Socialist States of Eastern Europe* (one vacancy): Hungary;

(e) *Western European and other States* (three vacancies): France, Italy, Netherlands and Norway.

1980/192. Election of members of the Committee on Natural Resources, the Commission on Transnational Corporations and the Ad Hoc Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting

At its 46th plenary meeting, on 7 November 1980, the Council decided to postpone to its organizational session for 1981 elections to fill vacancies in the following bodies:

- (a) *Committee on Natural Resources:*
 - (i) One member from Eastern European States and two members from Asian States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 1984;
 - (ii) Two members from Asian States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 1982;
- (b) *Commission on Transnational Corporations:*
 - (i) One member from Asian States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 1982;

- (ii) Two members from Asian States for a term beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 1983;

(c) *Ad Hoc Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting:*

One member from Asian States, one member from African States and two members from Eastern European States.
