

The above-mentioned organizations strongly recommend that the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Vomen of 1979 be included in the international human rights instruments to be considered at this session by the sessional Working Group. They do hope that ways and means will be found to encourage Governments which have not yet done so to ratify or adhere to this Convention.
