SECRETARY-GENERAL CALLS ON YEMEN'S LEADERS TO EXERCISE MAXIMIM RESTRAINT

Urges All Parties to Seek Peaceful Solution

The following statement is attributable to the Spokesman for Secretary-General Boutros Boutros-Ghali:

The Secretary-General has been following the situation in Yemen with growing concern. He appeals to the country's leaders to exercise maximum restraint lest intensification of the conflict imperil the unity and democracy which have been so widely hailed by the international community. He welcomes the mediation efforts of a number of Governments and organizations in the region and urges all concerned in Yemen to deepen their resolve to find a solution to the conflict through peaceful means and in accordance with the United Nations Charter.
