## OBSERVER STATUS FOR THE CENTRAL AMERICAN INTEGRATION SYSTEM IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Belize, Benin, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Czech Republic, Djibouti, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, France, Gabon, Germany, Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Italy, Jamaica, Mexico, Monaco, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Panama, Peru, Portugal, Romania, Rwanda, Spain, Suriname, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Uruguay and Zaire: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

<u>Considering</u> that the Tegucigalpa Protocol,  $\underline{1}$ / registered with this Organization, modifies the institutional structure in Central America formerly known as the Organization of Central American States, as well as the purposes and principles thereof, and has instituted the Central American Integration System,

<u>Noting</u> that respect for the purposes and principles embodied in the Charter of the United Nations is one of the basic principles of the Central American Integration System,

1. <u>Decides</u> to invite the Central American Integration System to participate in the sessions and the work of the General Assembly in the capacity of observer;

2. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to take the necessary action to implement the present resolution.
