LETTER DATED 16 OCTOBER 1995 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SECURITY
COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 724 (1991)
CONCERNING YUGOSLAVIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

On behalf of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 724 (1991) concerning Yugoslavia, I have the honour to apprise you of the fact that, according to a report dated 10 October 1995 by the Executive Director of the Danube Commission, completion of the repairs to the locks of the Iron Gates I system on the right bank of the Danube will require an additional 60 days.

The Committee considered the report and decided hereby to notify the Security Council, in accordance with paragraph 2 of Security Council resolution 992 (1995), that a further period of 60 days is required for completion of the necessary repairs to the locks of the Iron Gates I system on the right bank of the Danube.

It is the Committee's understanding that, unless the Security Council decides otherwise, resolution 992 (1995) shall remain in force for another period of 60 days, subject to paragraph 6 of that resolution, starting from 21 October and ending on 19 December 1995.
