Corrigendum

- 1. Replace paragraph 137 by the following:
 - 137. There is a need to continue to improve the impact of technical cooperation activities carried out by the United Nations system, including those that relate to youth activities. The United Nations system must continue to assist Governments, at their request, to ensure implementation of national plans and strategies within the national priorities and programmes to support youth activities. As administrative overheads can reduce the resources available for technical cooperation, these should be reduced. National execution should be the preferred modality for the implementation of projects and programmes and, where required, developing countries should be assisted to improve their national capacities for project and programme formulation and execution.
- 2. Insert as new paragraph 138, the following:
 - 138. The countries with economies in transition, where required, should also be assisted to improve their national capacities for project and programme formulation and execution.
- 3. Existing paragraphs 138-143 should be renumbered 139-144.
