Letter dated 10 November 1995 from the Permanent Representative of Slovenia to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to refer to the annex to the letter dated 31 October 1995 and signed by Mr. Vladislav Jovanović concerning the "activities of mercenaries in Bosnia and Herzegovina" (A/50/708-S/1995/908), and to bring to your attention the allegations contained in paragraph 4 of the annex that "the intelligence services of some other countries, such as ... Slovenia also participate in the recruitment of <u>mujaheddin</u> and their transfer to the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina" and that "training centres have been set up in Slovenia", etc.

I wish to inform you that these allegations are absolutely baseless.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 28 and 104, and of the Security Council.
