ELABORATION, PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 1 OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 48/37 of 9 DECEMBER 1993, OF AN INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION DEALING WITH THE SAFETY AND SECURITY OF UNITED NATIONS AND ASSOCIATED PERSONNEL, WITH PARTICULAR REFERENCE TO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ATTACKS ON SUCH PERSONNEL

Proposal by Austria

Article 8 bis

Transit State

- 1. For the purposes of this Convention, "transit State" means a State through which United Nations personnel pass in connection with a United Nations operation in a host State.
- 2. The consent of the transit State is required for the transit of United Nations personnel in connection with a United Nations operation.
- 3. The transit State shall accord to United Nations personnel such privileges and immunities as are necessary for the transit to and from a host State. Without prejudice to their privileges and immunities, United Nations personnel shall respect the laws and regulations of the transit State.
- 4. The transit State shall provide appropriate support to a United Nations operation, and in particular shall facilitate the transit of its personnel and equipment.
