Addendum

Letter dated 4 December 1995 from the President of the General Assembly to the Chairman of the Fifth Committee

I have the honour to inform you that, at the 77th plenary meeting of the fiftieth session held on Friday, 1 December, the General Assembly decided to allocate to the Fifth Committee the following item:

"Admission of the World Tourism Organization to membership in the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund" (item 166).

At the same meeting, the General Assembly also decided that, given its political importance, agenda item 164 (Normalization of the situation concerning South Africa) should be considered directly in plenary meeting, on the understanding that, owing to the financial complexity of the matter, the Fifth Committee would be invited to provide technical observations regarding the implementation of any draft resolutions to be submitted for action by the Assembly in plenary meeting.

The Assembly further decided that the Fifth Committee should be asked to submit its technical observations by 12 December 1995.

In accordance with the decision taken by the General Assembly, I therefore request, through you, that the Fifth Committee provide technical observations regarding the implementation of draft resolution A/50/L.44, entitled "Normalization of the situation concerning South Africa", by 12 December 1995.
