Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 19th meeting, on 3 November 1995, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/50/105) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of two of its members on 31 December 1995.
- 2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/49/10) containing the names of two persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1996.
- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should appoint Mr. Francis R. Spain (Ireland) and Ms. Deborah Taylor Ashford (United States of America) as members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1996.
