### FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS MISSION IN HAITI

#### Report of the Fifth Committee (Part II)

#### I. INTRODUCTION

1. Previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 133 appear in the report of the Committee contained in document A/50/705.
2. The Committee considered the item at its 33rd and 35th meetings, on 29 November and 1 December 1995. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/50/SR.33 and 35).
3. At the 33rd meeting, on 29 November, the Controller made a statement regarding the need for financial authority for the operation of the Mission beyond 30 November 1995.

#### II. CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT DECISION A/C.5/50/L.7

4. At its 35th meeting, on 1 December, the representative of Mexico introduced a draft decision entitled "Financing of the United Nations Mission in Haiti" (A/C.5/50/L.7), submitted on the basis of informal consultations.
5. At the same meeting, the Fifth Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/50/L.7 without a vote (see para. 6).

III. RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS MISSION IN HAITI

The General Assembly decides, on an exceptional basis, to authorize the Secretary-General to enter into commitments for the operation of the United Nations Mission in Haiti for the period from 1 to 15 December 1995 in the amount of 10,601,120 United States dollars gross (10,420,020 dollars net).
