INFORMATION CIRCULAR

Subject: POST ADJUSTMENT MULTIPLIER FOR NEW YORK*

1. The International Civil Service Commission has determined that the requirement for the application of post adjustment multiplier 46.5 for staff in the Professional and higher categories serving in New York has been met as of 1 November 1995. Consequently, effective 1 November 1995, the post adjustment multiplier for New York is being revised from 37.6 to 46.5.
2. The annual amounts of post adjustment at multiplier 46.5 for each salary level and step are shown in the annex to the present circular.
3. In the light of the current financial constraints facing the Organization, the Secretary-General has decided to defer payments due in accordance with this decision of the Commission for staff of the United Nations until January 1996.
