#### Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 43rd meeting, on 20 December 1995, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/50/48) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution entitled "The situation in Burundi". The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/50/SR.43).

#### DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/50/L.59/Rev.1, an additional appropriation not exceeding \$1,872,000 would be required under section 3, Peace-keeping operations and special missions, of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1996-1997. An additional amount not exceeding \$171,000 would also be required under section 32, Staff assessment, offset by the same amount under income section 1, Income from staff assessment.
