FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS PEACE-KEEPING FORCE IN CYPRUS

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Peter MADDENS (Belgium)

- 1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 22 September 1995, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fiftieth session the item entitled "Financing of the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 41st meeting, on 17 December 1995. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/50/SR.41).
- 3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of the United Nations Peace-keeping Force in Cyprus (A/50/722 and Corr.1) and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/50/802).
- 4. At its 41st meeting, on 17 December, on the oral proposal of the Chairman, the Committee adopted a draft decision entitled "Financing of the United Nations Peace-keeping Force in Cyprus" (see para. 5).

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

5. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Financing of the United Nations Peace-keeping Force in Cyprus

The General Assembly, having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of the United Nations Peace-keeping Force in Cyprus $\underline{1}/$ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, $\underline{2}/$ endorses the observations and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee, and in particular, paragraph 41 thereof.
