ENVIRONMENT AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

Report of the Second Committee (Part I)*

Rapporteur: Mr. Basheer F. ZOUBI (Jordan)

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 22 September 1995, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fiftieth session the item entitled:

"Environment and sustainable development:

- "(a) Implementation of decisions and recommendations of the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development;
- "(b) Desertification and drought;
- "(d) Protection of global climate for present and future generations of mankind;
- "(e) Implementation of the outcome of the Global Conference on the Sustainable Development of Small Island Developing States;
- "(f) International Decade for Natural Disaster Reduction"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

- 2. At the same meeting, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fiftieth session sub-item 96 (c) entitled "Sustainable use and conservation of the marine living resources of the high seas" and to consider it directly in plenary meeting.
- 3. The Second Committee held general discussions on the item at its 18th to 23rd, 34th, 35th and 39th meetings, on 30 and 31 October, from 1 to 3 November and on 15, 16 and 27 November 1995. The general discussion on sub-items (a) and (b) was held at the 18th to 23rd meetings, on 30 and 31 October and from 1 to 3 November. The general discussion on sub-items (d) and (e) was held at the 34th and 35th meetings, on 15 and 16 November. The general discussion on sub-item (f) was held at the 39th meeting, on 27 November.
