FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS MISSION OF OBSERVERS IN TAJIKISTAN

## I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 22 September 1995, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fiftieth session the item entitled "Financing of the United Nations Mission of Observers in Tajikistan" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the reports of the Secretary-General (A/50/749) and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/50/802).

3. The Committee considered the item at its 41st meeting, on 17 December. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/50/SR.41).

II. CONSIDERATION OF A DRAFT DECISION PRESENTED ORALLY BY THE CHAIRMAN

4. At the 41st meeting, on 17 December, the Chairman presented orally a draft decision on the financing of the United Nations Mission of Observers in Tajikistan, which was amended by the representative of the Netherlands.

5. At the same meeting, the Fifth Committee adopted the draft decision without a vote (see para. 6).

## III. RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

## Financing of the United Nations Mission of Observers in Tajikistan

The General Assembly, having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of the United Nations Mission of Observers in Tajikistan, 1/ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, 2/

(a) Decides that, for Member States that have fulfilled their financial obligations to the Mission, there shall be set off against their future apportionments their respective share in the unencumbered balance of 378,600 United States dollars gross (373,800 dollars net) for the period from 16 December 1994 to 16 June 1995;

(b) Decides also that, for Member States that have not fulfilled their financial obligations to the Mission, their share of the unencumbered balance of 378,600 dollars gross (373.800 dollars net) for the period from 16 December 1994 to 16 June 1995 shall be set off against their outstanding obligations.
