- At its 42nd and 43rd meetings, on 18 and 20 December 1995, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/50/44) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution II, entitled "Follow-up to the Fourth World Conference on Women and full implementation of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action", recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 14 of its report (A/50/816). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman (see A/C.5/50/SR.42).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution II recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 14 of its report (A/50/816), an additional appropriation not to exceed the amount of

\$356,600 would be required under section 7A, Department for Policy Coordination and Sustainable Development, of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1996-1997. Such an appropriation would be subject to the guidelines for the use and operation of the contingency fund.
