ADOPTION OF THE REPORT (A/AC.182/L.26 and Add.1 and 2, L.27 and Add.1 and 2, L.28, L.29)

1. The CHAIRMAN drew attention to the documents before the Committee, some of which were not listed in the Journal because they had only become available that morning.
2. Mr. ROSENSTOCK (United States of America) said his delegation regretted that all the important documents before the Committee, with the exception of document A/AC.182/L.26, had been distributed too late for them to be studied.
3. Mr. SMIRNOV (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics), supported by Mr. MARDAN (Iraq), Mr. OLSZOWKA (Poland) and Mr. GÜNEY (Turkey), proposed that the meeting should be adjourned so that consultations could be held among the regional groups on the documents which had only just been distributed.
