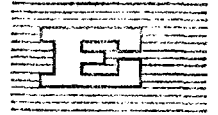

QUESTION OF THE VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN THE OCCUPIED
ARAB TERRITORIES, INCLUDING PALESTINE

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In paragraph 14 of its resolution 1 A (XXXVI) the Commission on Human Rights requested the Secretary-General to bring to the attention of the Commission, in connexion with its consideration of this item, all United Nations reports appearing between sessions of the Commission that deal with the situation of the civilians of the occupied Arab territories, including Palestine.
2. The Secretary-General accordingly draws the attention of the Commission to the United Nations reports listed hereunder, which have been issued since the closure of its thirty-sixth session on 14 March 1980:
