2. The biographical data of Mr. Raúl Ferrero, whose candidature was listed in E/CN.4/1446/Add.2, are given below.

MR. RAUL FERRERO COSTA

(Nominated by the Government of Peru)

Born on 17 March 1941. Studied the humanities and law at the Catholic University of Lima. Graduated as a lawyer in 1965.

Worked in the legal department of Grace & Co. from 1959 to 1966.

Teacher of World History and Peruvian Geography at the Antonio Raimondi College from 1959 to 1962. Town Councillor, Municipality of Lima, 1963. Legal adviser of the Workers' Trade Union of the Mercado Minorista from 1964. President of the "JUEVES" Artistic and Cultural Association, Lima.

In 1966, he went to the United Kingdom, where he studied economics at the London School of Economics, and administrative and economic development at Leeds University.

Legal adviser to the Peruvian Social Security Programme in the period 1967-1969. Lawyer in the Estudio Ferrero from 1967. Legal adviser to the Atlas Insurance Co. and to the Asociación Peruana de Empresas de Seguros (Peruvian Association of Insurance Companies) from 1968. Adviser and member of the board of directors of various industrial and commercial companies at Lima. Member of various advisory committees of the Lima College of Advocates.

Represented the Asociación de Aseguradores del Perú at the First Inter-American Congress on Export Credit Insurance, held at Bogotá in 1970. Was rapporteur of the Peruvian delegation to the First Meeting of Insurers of the Andean Group, held at Lima (September 1970).

Representative of the Asociación de Aseguradores del Perú in the study tour on export credit insurance systems, which took place in France, Germany, the Netherlands, the United Kingdom, Canada and Mexico, under the auspices of the Inter-American Development Bank.

Lectured in civil law at the Universidad Nacional Mayor de San Marcos.

Obtained his doctorate of law at the Universidad Nacional Mayor de San Marcos in 1974, with distinction and a recommendation that his thesis be published.

Among other legal works, he has published El Negocio Jurídico (Legal transactions), El Seguro de Crédito a la Exportación (Export credit insurance), Los Derechos Humanos (Human Rights), etc.

Worked as a staff member of the United Nations Division of Human Rights at Geneva from February 1975 to February 1977.

Was a member of the secretariat of the Commission on Human Rights at its February 1976 session. Was also a member of the secretariat of the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities at its August 1976 session.

Was secretary of the Working Group on violations of human rights in Chile, and took part in the preparation of two of the reports submitted to the General Assembly.

Attended the Symposium on International Law and Development held in Algeria in October 1976.

Was invited by the Société Française pour le Droit International to the symposium on the dissemination of information on international law, held at Strasbourg, France, at the beginning of June 1977.

1978-1980 member of the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities.
