ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION AT THE RESUMED ORGANIZATIONAL SESSION FOR 1993

Note by the Secretariat

Item 5. <u>Institutional arrangements to follow up the United Nations</u> <u>Conference on Environment and Development</u>

1. In resolution 47/191, the General Assembly requested the Economic and Social Council, at its organizational session for 1993, to set up a high-level Commission on Sustainable Development as a functional commission of the Council, in order, <u>inter alia</u>, to ensure effective follow-up of the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development. The Assembly also recommended that in 1993, as a transitional measure, the Commission hold a short organizational session in New York to elect the Bureau of the Commission, decide on the agenda of its first substantive session and consider all other organizational issues as might be necessary.

2. In the same resolution, the Assembly endorsed the view of the Secretary-General that a high-level advisory board on sustainable development should be established and decided that the main task of the board would be to give broad consideration to issues related to the implementation of Agenda 21 and to provide expert advice in that regard to the Secretary-General and, through him, to the Commission, the Economic and Social Council and the General Assembly.

3. At its organizational session for 1993, the Economic and Social Council decided to establish the Commission on Sustainable Development as a functional commission of the Council; it also decided that an organizational session of the Commission should be held at Headquarters from 24 to 26 February 1993 (decision 1993/207). The Council will have before it the report of the Commission on Sustainable Development on its organizational session.

4. At the same session, the Council took note of the proposals of the Secretary-General concerning the High-level Advisory Board on Sustainable Development, as contained in his report (E/1993/15 and Corr.1), and decided to
