Note du Secrétariat

1. Dans sa résolution 47/180 du 22 décembre 1992 relative à la Conférence des Nations Unies sur les établissements humains (Habitat II), l'Assemblée générale a invité les organisations non gouvernementales, notamment celles de pays en développement, y compris celles liées aux groupes principaux, à participer et contribuer à la Conférence et à ses préparatifs et décidé, à cette fin, que le Comité préparatoire formulerait et adopterait les modalités d'accréditation et de participation de ces organisations en tenant compte des procédures appliquées pour la Conférence des Nations Unies sur l'environnement et le développement.
2. En application de ladite résolution, le Comité préparatoire a adopté, à sa session d'organisation, le règlement intérieur régissant la participation des organisations non gouvernementales (voir A/48/37, sect. III). Le secrétariat de la Conférence s'est servi de ce règlement, qui est similaire à celui qui avait été établi lors de la Conférence des Nations Unies sur l'environnement et le développement, pour évaluer les demandes d'accréditation soumises par les organisations non gouvernementales.
3. La présente note fournit au Comité préparatoire de la Conférence des informations pertinentes sur les organisations non gouvernementales qui ne sont pas dotées du statut consultatif auprès du Conseil économique et social ou ne sont pas inscrites sur la liste du Conseil et qui ont demandé à être accréditées auprès de la Conférence et de ses organes préparatoires.
