LETTER DATED 14 MARCH 1996 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1011 (1995), adopted by the Security Council on 16 August 1995, regarding the situation in Rwanda. In paragraph 12 of that resolution, I was requested to report to the Council within six months of the date of its adoption, regarding, in particular, the export of arms and related <a href="material">material</a> to the Government of Rwanda, on the basis of reports submitted by the Committee established pursuant to resolution 918 (1994) concerning Rwanda.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that during this period, the Committee established pursuant to resolution 918 (1994) concerning Rwanda has received no notifications concerning the export to, or the import by, the Government of Rwanda of arms and related <a href="mailto:material">matériel</a>. However, a notification was received on 12 February 1996 from the Government of Singapore informing the Committee that it had exported spare parts for vehicles for use by the Ministry of Defence of Rwanda. Before notifying the Security Council, the Committee has requested from the Government of Singapore additional information concerning this export.
