Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 65th meeting, on 11 May 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/121 and Add.1) on the administrative and financial implications of draft decision A/35/L.60/Rev.1. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/35/SR.65).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft decision A/35/L.60/Rev.l, no additional appropriation would be required at this time. Additional conference-servicing costs as detailed in document A/C.5/35/121/Add.l would arise and would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement, to be submitted by the Secretary-General to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, on the over-all level of conference resources required in the light of the pattern of conferences for the year 1981 as approved by the General Assembly.
