Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 65th meeting, on 11 May 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/121 and Add.1) on the administrative and financial implications of draft decision A/35/L.60/Rev.1. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/35/SR.65).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft decision A/35/L.60/Rev.1, no additional appropriation would be required at this time. Additional conference-servicing costs as detailed in document A/C.5/35/121/Add.1 would arise and would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement, to be submitted by the Secretary-General to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, on the over-all level of conference resources required in the light of the pattern of conferences for the year 1981 as approved by the General Assembly.
