I. INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 1994

Introduction

1. The Executive Director of the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) submits herewith the financial report of the accounts of UNICEF for the year ended 31 December 1994, the first year of the biennium 1994-1995, comprising 12 statements and 1 schedule. The financial report provides the details of the 1994 financial results of UNICEF activities. Highlights are summarized in the following paragraphs.

Income

2. UNICEF income in the year 1994 totalled \$1,006 million. Virtually all Governments of both industrialized and developing countries contributed to UNICEF in 1994. Income comprised \$535 million for general resources and \$471 million for supplementary funds. This included \$213 million in emergency contributions. The breakdown of UNICEF income by source is: 65 per cent (\$659 million) from Governments and intergovernmental organizations; 28 per cent (\$279 million) from fund-raising campaigns, greeting card profit and individual donations; 2 per cent (\$20 million) from the United Nations system; and 5 per cent (\$48 million) from miscellaneous sources, including interest and exchange rate revaluation of assets and liabilities.

Expenditures

3. UNICEF expenditures in 1994 were \$991 million. This amount consisted of \$496 million for programme cooperation from general resources and \$404 million for programme cooperation from supplementary funds. The remaining expenditures of \$91 million were for administrative services.

Donations-in-kind

4. Donations-in-kind valued by donors at \$19 million were delivered by UNICEF to projects during 1994. These deliveries are not reflected in the financial accounts of UNICEF, although they are handled through the administrative structures of the organization.

Special accounts

5. Special accounts that are not related to programmes approved by the UNICEF Executive Board are not entered in the financial accounts of UNICEF as income and expenditures. These funds are used mainly to cover the cost of goods and services purchased and delivered on a reimbursable basis by UNICEF on behalf of Governments, other agencies in the United Nations system and non-governmental organizations (NGOs). In 1994, UNICEF received cash or pledges of \$105 million for the special accounts. Disbursements and obligations totalled \$95 million, and \$6 million were either returned to donors or approved by donors for other services.

Cash holdings

6. Total cash of \$463 million (which includes the unspent balances from special accounts in the amount of \$81 million) was held with first-class banks. This amount comprised \$428 million in interest-bearing time deposit accounts and \$35 million in current bank accounts. The total cash holdings of UNICEF included \$26 million in currencies restricted for use in the donor countries for purchases and other local expenditures.

Approved programmes

7. During 1994, the Executive Board approved the amount of \$810 million for new programmes for children in countries with which UNICEF cooperates, as well as for regional and interregional projects. This total includes \$349 million in programmes to be funded from UNICEF general resources and \$461 million for projects that the Board approved as worthy of support and that were to be financed by pledges of supplementary funds.

Notes to the financial statements

Note 1: Summary of significant accounting policies

1. Until 31 December 1987, UNICEF accounts were maintained in accordance with the Financial Regulations of the United Nations, with such modifications as required by the nature of the work of UNICEF. At its 1987 regular session, the Executive Board, by its decision 1987/13 (E/ICEF/1987/11), adopted the UNICEF Financial Regulations and Rules in accordance with Economic and Social Council decision 1986/1981 of 23 July 1986, as approved by the General Assembly in its decision 41/461 of 11 December 1986.

Accounting period

2. At its 1987 regular session, the Executive Board, by its decision 1987/2 (E/ICEF/1987/11), decided that effective 1 January 1988, UNICEF would commence its financial reporting on a biennial basis. Since 1 January 1988, the accounts have been maintained on a biennial basis in accordance with the UNICEF Financial Regulations and Rules.

Unit of account

3. The accounting unit is the United States dollar. The equivalent in United States dollars of other currencies is established on the basis of the United Nations operational rates of exchange.

Translation of currencies

4. Differences between the valuation of the currencies when entered into the accounts and when actual transactions are completed are accounted for as gains or losses on exchange transactions.

5. Periodically, assets and liabilities in currencies other than United States dollars are revalued for accounting purposes at the prevailing United Nations operational rates of exchange. Any variance due to fluctuation of those rates is accounted for as income or loss and shown separately in the statement of income and expenditure. In accordance with UNICEF Executive Board decision 1990/28 (E/ICEF/1990/13), differences resulting from the payment of contributions pledged in currencies other than United States dollars are recorded against the contributions.

Income

6. Income consists of general resources and supplementary funds. General resources include funds from the voluntary annual contributions of Governments, intergovernmental organizations, NGOs, the net income from Greeting Card and related Operations (GCO), un earmarked funds contributed by the public and other income. Supplementary funds are those contributed to UNICEF by Governments, intergovernmental organizations, NGOs and United Nations agencies for emergencies and for specific purposes within the programmes approved by the UNICEF Executive Board.

7. Income is recorded on the basis of funds or pledges received for the current year.

8. Contributions income received from National Committees for UNICEF and NGOs is accounted for on a cash basis of accounting, with the exception of supplementary funds and emergency contributions, which may be recorded on the basis of a valid pledge from a National Committee. The validity of the pledge is

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determined by the existence of funds raised and a statement from the National Committee that it is committing funds to UNICEF in the form of a pledge.

9. All other income received by UNICEF is classified as miscellaneous income and is credited as general resources.

10. The statement of income and expenditure does not include funds received and expenditures made from special accounts. Those transactions which do not require commitments by the Executive Board are maintained as special accounts.

11. Donations-in-kind, which are recorded as memorandum entries in the books of accounts, are not part of UNICEF income.

#### Expenditure

12. All expenditure of UNICEF is accounted for on an accrual basis, except for that relating to staff entitlements, which is accounted for on the basis of cash disbursements only.

13. Deferred charges comprise expenditure items which are not properly chargeable in the current financial period and which will be charged as expenditure in a subsequent financial period.

14. No provision is made for staff entitlements for repatriation, etc., that will take place in the future or to meet contingencies under appendix D of the United Nations Staff Rules, as funds are provided in the budget appropriations as required.

#### Assets

15. All funds received are deposited into UNICEF bank accounts, including those under special account arrangements, and reflected as cash holdings.

16. Prior to 1989, certain buildings purchased by UNICEF and considered as capital assets were valued at cost less accumulated depreciation. In 1989, the unamortized value of UNICEF capital assets was expended against the 1988-1989 budget, resulting in a fully depreciated UNICEF capital asset account as of 31 December 1989. Future acquisitions of UNICEF capital assets will be included in the capital asset fund (see paragraph 21 below).

17. The stock of programme supplies at the UNICEF Supply Division warehouse at Copenhagen is shown at average cost. Goods in transit to the warehouse are valued at actual cost. Freight paid for supplies to the warehouse is considered part of the cost of supplies.

18. The GCO inventory of raw materials, products in process and finished goods are valued at standard cost.

19. Furniture, equipment and other non-expendable property are not included in the assets of the organization. Acquisitions are charged against budgetary accounts in the year of purchase.

#### Liabilities and reserves

20. The liabilities of UNICEF include contributions received in advance, special accounts, unliquidated obligations, other accounts payable, credit balances and accrued expenses.

21. By its decision 1990/26 (E/ICEF/1990/13) taken in its 1990 regular session, the Executive Board approved the establishment of a capital asset reserve fund to better control the future purchase of UNICEF capital assets, mainly buildings to be purchased for office accommodations and staff housing in the field. At such

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time as may be necessary, additional authorized appropriations will be made to replenish the capital asset reserve.

Consolidation of GCO accounts

22. The financial report and accounts reflect UNICEF income, expenditure, assets and liabilities, including the net operating income, assets and liabilities of GCO. The principles of consolidation reflect the accounting policies outlined below:

(a) The reporting period and accounts of GCO are maintained on a fiscal year basis, ending 30 April. However, for consolidation purposes only, the UNICEF financial statements include the GCO accounts on a calendar year basis, as at 31 December, based on the trial balance of the GCO accounts;

(b) The financial effect of consolidating the GCO accounts on a calendar basis is reflected, most notably, in the receivables and earnings of GCO. Inter-office transactions between UNICEF and GCO are eliminated for consolidation purposes.

Note 2: Income

23. Total income from contributions for the year ended 31 December 1994 was \$1,005,897,819, an increase of \$140,174,583 compared to the year ended 31 December 1993. Contributions for the year ended 31 December 1994 consisted of \$376,750,833 for general resources and \$467,760,253 for supplementary funds.

24. Net income from GCO for the year ended 31 December 1994 was \$113,367,920.

25. Income from miscellaneous sources for the year ended 31 December 1994 was \$40,249,584. The major items are \$18,246,217 in interest on funds held in interest-bearing deposits and in current accounts with banks, \$6,586,974 in adjustments of accounts payable related to the programme budget of the prior biennium, \$5,898,679 in adjustments of accounts payable related to the administrative budget of the prior biennium and \$3,251,689 in income from packing and assembly activities.

26. Changes in the value of the United States dollar (the accounting unit) in relation to other currencies in which assets and liabilities were held and other adjustments resulted in a net increase of \$7,769,229 in the accounting value of these assets and liabilities during the year ended 31 December 1994, composed, for the most part, of the following:

Note 3: Donations-in-kind

27. Donations-in-kind valued by donors and accepted by the Executive Director at \$18,738,584 were delivered by UNICEF to projects during 1994. These are recorded as memorandum entries in the books of accounts and are not part of UNICEF income.

Note 4: Expenditures

28. The total expenditures for the year 1994 amounted to \$991,138,995, which are \$7,165,667 higher than the total expenditures of the prior year. Expenditures for

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programme cooperation during the current year totalled \$899,726,743, or \$2,772,957 higher than for the year 1993.

29. Expenditures for administrative services in 1994 were \$91,412,252. In the year 1993, the comparative amount was \$87,019,542.

**Note 5: Write-offs**

30. The amount of \$8,195,947 shown on statement I includes the write-off and adjustment of pledges for the year ended 31 December 1994 totalling \$8,032,255. Adjustments for write-offs of other assets and losses amounted to \$163,692. The write-off and adjustment of pledges consist of:

**Note 6: Assets**

31. As of 31 December 1994, cash totalled \$463,439,738 (statement II). Included in this amount are \$81,289,130 held on behalf of donors, mainly for the procurement of goods and services on a reimbursable basis.

32. Contributions receivable for current and prior years totalled \$199,114,153 as of 31 December 1994. Included in contributions receivable are \$188,698,930 for supplementary funds, payment of which is normally related to the progress in implementing specific projects and occurs in accordance with payment schedules agreed upon with donors.

33. Contributions received in advance totalled \$74,355,082 as at 31 December 1994. These contributions will be recorded as income in following years in accordance with the conditions specified in the relevant pledge.

34. The aggregate of accounts receivable, advances and deposits as at 31 December 1994 totalled \$162,229,319, including the accounts of GCO, which total \$120,556,517.

35. The aggregate value of inventory as at 31 December 1994 totalled \$52,464,143, consisting mainly of programme supplies in stock at the UNICEF Supply Division warehouse at Copenhagen and GCO stock.

36. Capital assets reflected on statement II as at 31 December 1994 consist of UNICEF office buildings and staff housing presented at their acquisition cost of \$11,526,317, as well as GCO machinery and equipment which has a depreciated value of \$1,761,730. Details of UNICEF capital sets, except GCO, are given in statement IX.

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37. The value of non-expendable property as at 31 December 1994 totalled \$41,151,782. This represents the non-expendable property of all except three UNICEF offices. Computer equipment acquired in 1994 has been charged against the administrative budget, a procedure consistently applied since 1986, and is not reflected in the statements.

38. As at 31 December 1994, the organization's call accounts and time deposits were valued at \$428,195,166. The application of the United Nations rates of exchange as of 1 January 1995 will result in a foreign exchange loss of \$506,677 and decrease the value of the call accounts and time deposits to \$427,688,489.

Note 7: Reserve

39. In 1950, the Executive Board authorized the establishment of a reserve for insurance of \$200,000 to absorb losses of UNICEF programme supplies and equipment not covered by commercial insurance. Up to 1992, the reserve was restored to its authorized limit by a transfer from income. There were no movements in the reserve account in 1994 and the reserve had a balance of \$200,000 as at 31 December, 1994.

40. In 1987, UNICEF established a reserve of \$100,000 to self-insure for property losses. This reserve was funded equally from the biennium 1986-1987 and the biennium 1988-1989. Up to 1992, the reserve was restored to its original amount by a transfer from income. The balance of the reserve account as at 31 December 1993 was \$28,274. There were no movements in the reserve account in 1994 and the reserve had a balance of \$28,274 as at 31 December 1994.

41. The procedure of replenishing the reserve accounts from income was discontinued in 1993.

Note 8: Contingent liability - staff benefits

42. Staff members' accumulated annual leave as at 31 December 1993 has an estimated value of \$25,036,113. There is no provision in the accounts in respect of this amount. The expenditures will be charged against the budget appropriations of the periods when actual payments are made.
