Savings represent unused balances of approved programmes owing to price reductions in the supplies or equipment required, overestimation of the amount of supplies and non-supply assistance needed and cancellations when UNICEF assistance is no longer required because the project, or some aspect of it, cannot proceed as originally envisaged or because financing is assumed by other sources.
