LETTER DATED 18 APRIL 1996 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Some months ago, my Special Representative for Cyprus, Mr. Joe Clark, advised me that because of other commitments he would not be in a position to remain in this post much longer. However, he very kindly agreed to stay on until a suitable successor could be appointed.

I wish to take this opportunity to put on record my profound appreciation for the high degree of professionalism and devotion displayed by Mr. Joe Clark throughout his service as my Special Representative.

As my new Special Representative for Cyprus I have decided to appoint Mr. Han Sung-Joo, former Foreign Minister of the Republic of Korea, effective 1 May 1996. Mr. Gustave Feissel will continue as my Deputy Special Representative, resident in Cyprus, and as Chief of Mission of the United Nations Operation in Cyprus.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
