Note by the Secretary-General

1. The table appearing in the annex to the present note, indicating the prorated share of the individual peace-keeping operations of the cost of backstopping requirements at Headquarters funded from the support account for the 12-month period from 1 July 1996 to 30 June 1997, has been submitted in accordance with the recommendation contained in paragraph 37 of the report 1/ of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions and the procedures outlined in paragraphs 1 and 2 of the appendix to the letter from the Controller dated 15 March 1996. 2/
2. The Advisory Committee in paragraph 33 of its report 1/ has recommended that the General Assembly authorize the amount of \$31,346,400.
