“ 21. The Co-ordination Committee agreed that the question, as raised in the Social Committee, should be given priority at the twelfth session of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs in 1957, second only to the priority accorded to the consideration of the Draft Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, regarding which the Council had adopted resolution 626 F (XXII). The Commission would thus consider the matter at that session and would be able to make recommendations to the Council on subsequent priorities in its report.”
