647 (XXIII). Membership of the Technical Assistance Committee

The Economic and Social Council,

Taking into consideration General Assembly resolution 1036 (XI) of 26 February 1957 on the membership of the Technical Assistance Committee,

Noting the provisions of paragraph 6 of Council resolution 222 A (IX) of 15 August 1949,

Decides that:

- 1. The Technical Assistance Committee shall consist, as from 1 June 1957, of the following:
 - (a) The members of the Council;
- (b) Six members to be elected by the Council from among the States Members of the United Nations or members of the specialized agencies, having due regard

to geographical distribution and to the representation of contributing and recipient countries having an important interest in the Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance;

- 2. The term of office of the members of the Technical Assistance Committee referred to under paragraph 1 (b) above shall be two years, except that at the initial election the Council shall elect six members, the term of office of three of which shall end on 31 December 1958, whereas the term of office of the other three shall end on 31 December 1959:
- 3. In the event that a member of the Technical Assistance Committee referred to under paragraph 1 (b) above becomes a member of the Council, the Council shall elect another State to the membership of the Committee for the remainder of the term of office of that member.
