

**RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL DURING ITS
RESUMED TWENTY-EIGHTH SESSION**

745 (XXVIII). Organization and operation of the Council

The Economic and Social Council,

Having taken note of the discussions of the General Assembly at its fourteenth session,

Having considered the note by the Secretary-General¹ concerning the desirability and usefulness of meetings of the Council at the ministerial level,

1. *Approves* the principle of the Secretary-General's proposal;
2. *Requests* the Secretary-General to proceed with the arrangements for such a meeting along the lines suggested in paragraph 9 of his note;
3. *Further requests* that the Secretary-General, in the formulation of his proposal on this subject for the twenty-ninth session of the Council, take into account the views expressed at the resumed twenty-eighth session.
