Letter dated 13 May 1996 from the Permanent Representative
of Cyprus to the United Nations addressed to the
Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention a serious matter arising out of an advertisement published in the Turkish-Cypriot newspaper Cyprus Today dated 6 April 1996 (see annex). The advertisement reveals a new provocative act on the part of the Turkish occupation forces in Cyprus to sell the Byzantine Church of Panagia Chrysotrimithiotissa at the occupied village of Trimithi. According to the advertisement, Keskin and Smith Estate Agents is selling the Church for £32,500.

The Church of Panagia Chrysotrimithiotissa belongs to the Bishopric of Kyrenia and it dates back to the middle-Byzantine period. In 1974, the Church was included in a list of other monuments to be listed by the Government as ancient monuments.

The Government of the Republic of Cyprus has brought to your attention repeated acts of sacrilege and vandalism of churches and monasteries in the part of Cyprus occupied by Turkey since 1974 in order to stop Turkey's systematic efforts to erase the Greek cultural heritage in the occupied part of Cyprus.

This new development is yet another example of the existence of a premeditated plan by the Turkish occupying power to change the demographic structure of the occupied area by importing thousands of illegal settlers from Anatolia, Turkey, and to eradicate the cultural heritage of the indigenous Greek Cypriot population in that area.

The Government of the Republic of Cyprus strongly protests over this illegal, sacrilegious and condemnable act, and requests that the United Nations proceed expeditiously to take the necessary measures to promptly prevent its realization.



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I should be grateful if the text of the present letter and its annex could be circulated as a document of the fiftieth session of the General Assembly, under agenda items 55 and 112, and of the Security Council.

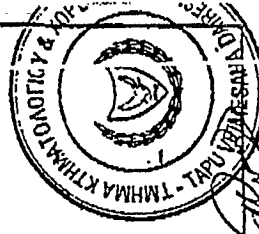
