Compilation of corrections suggested to the draft Habitat Agenda

The compilation of corrections contained in the present document was submitted by the Member States of the United Nations that are members of the European Union and should be read in connection with the draft Habitat Agenda (A/CONF.165/L.1).

1. <u>Page 4, paragraph 2 ter</u>

The last two sentences of the paragraph, which are between brackets, should be removed from the paragraph and form a separate paragraph numbered 2 <u>bis</u>. As a consequence, the present paragraphs 2 <u>bis</u> and 2 <u>ter</u> should be renumbered 2 <u>ter</u> and 2 <u>quater</u>.
