NOTE VERBALE DATED 22 MAY 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF SPAIN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Spain to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, in reply to his note of 15 May 1996, has the honour to inform him that the Government of Spain, in compliance with paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996), has instructed all diplomatic missions and consulates of Spain abroad to deny visas for entry into and transit through Spanish territory to members of the Government of the Sudan, officials of that Government and members of the Sudanese armed forces, with effect from 10 May 1996. These measures will remain in effect for as long as the Sudan persists in its attitude of non-compliance with the demands made in the relevant Security Council resolutions.

Since the Sudan has no diplomatic mission in Spain and Spain has no embassy in the Sudan, subparagraph 3 (a) of resolution 1054 (1996) does not apply.
