SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3659th meeting, held on 25 April 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the letter dated 12 April 1996 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1996/313).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Burundi, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1996/21; to be issued in <u>Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and</u> <u>Decisions of the Security Council, 1996</u>).

Letter dated 9 January 1996 from the Permanent Representative of Ethiopia to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council concerning the extradition of the suspects wanted in the assassination attempt on the life of the President of the Arab Republic of Egypt in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, on <u>26 June 1995 (S/1996/10)</u> (see S/1996/15/Add.4)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3660th meeting, held on 26 April 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General pursuant to Security Council resolution 1044 (1996) (S/1996/179).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Ethiopia, Sudan and Uganda, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/293) that had been submitted by Botswana, Chile, Egypt, Guinea-Bissau and Honduras, and to a technical correction to paragraph 1 (a) of the English version thereof.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/293, which received 13 votes in favour with 2 abstentions (China and the Russian Federation) and was adopted as resolution 1054 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1054 (1996); to be issued in <u>Official Records of the Security Council</u>, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
