## SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

## Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/336 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1055 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1055 (1996); to be issued in <u>Official Records of the Security Council</u>, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
