## Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

During the week ending  $18\ \mathrm{May}\ 1996$ , the Security Council took action on the following items:

The situation in Burundi (see S/25070/Add.43, S/25070/Add.46, S/1994/20/Add.29, S/1994/20/Add.33, S/1994/20/Add.41, S/1994/20/Add.50, S/1995/40/Add.4, S/1995/40/Add.9, S/1995/40/Add.12, S/1995/40/Add.34, S/1996/15, S/1996/15/Add.4, S/1996/15/Add.9 and S/1996/15/Add.16)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3664th meeting, held on 15 May 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the situation in Burundi (S/1996/335).

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1996/24; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
