LETTER DATED 28 MAY 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF KUWAIT TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I refer to your letter dated 15 May 1996, reference number SCA/2/96 (10-1), requesting the submission of a report on the steps taken by the Government of Kuwait to give effect to the provisions set out in paragraph 3 (a) of resolution 1054 (1996). Those provisions require all States to significantly reduce the number and the level of the staff at Sudanese diplomatic missions and consular posts and to restrict or control the movement within their territory of all such staff who remain. I have the honour to inform you that the Sudan currently has no diplomatic or consular representation in Kuwait and that Kuwait for its part, has reduced its diplomatic representation in Khartoum to the level of a chargé d'affaires and an administrative employee.
