Appointment of members of the Preparatory Committee for the
United Nations Conference for the Promotion of International
Co-operation in the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Further to his communication of 1 July 1981 (see A/35/805), the President of the General Assembly, on 31 July 1981, informed the Secretary-General, on the basis of information transmitted to him by the Chairman of the Group of African States, that he had appointed the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Mauritania and Morocco as members of the Preparatory Committee for the United Nations Conference for the Promotion of International Co-operation in the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy.
