Statement by the Presidency of the European Union on the
removal of nuclear warheads from Ukrainian territory,
issued at Brussels on 12 June 1996

The Presidency warmly welcomes President Kouchma's announcement that all nuclear warheads have been removed from Ukrainian territory. Ukraine has thus fulfilled the obligation undertaken in January 1994 when she signed the Trilateral Agreement with the Russian Federation and the United States.

The Presidency believes that the timely achievement of this important development is a further demonstration of Ukrainian commitment to disarmament and nuclear non-proliferation. It represents a significant complement to the earlier decision by Ukraine to accede to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons as a non-nuclear-weapon State.
