LETTER DATED 12 JUNE 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BRAZIL TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

With reference to Security Council resolution 1054 (1996), which determines the implementation of diplomatic sanctions against the Government of the Sudan, I have the honour to inform you that Brazil and the Sudan have no diplomatic missions or consular posts in their respective territories. Furthermore, the Brazilian authorities are taking all adequate measures regarding the entry into and transit through the territory of Brazil of those Sudanese nationals included in the provisions set forth in paragraph 3 of the above-mentioned Security Council resolution.
