POLICIES OF APARTHEID OF THE GOVERNMENT OF SOUTH AFRICA

Letter dated 2 June 1981 from the Permanent Representative of Nicaragua to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that the members of the Junta of the Government of National Reconstruction sent the following message to the Chairman of the International Conference on Sanctions against South Africa on 21 May 1981:

"On behalf of the people and Revolutionary Government of Nicaragua, we have the honour to congratulate you on your well-deserved election and to request you to inform the International Conference on Sanctions against South Africa of the steadfast support of Nicaragua for an international appeal for full implementation of the measures envisaged in Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.

"In the light of the criminal acts of aggression of the racist régime against the front-line States and its intention to perpetuate its illegal rule in Namibia and to justify the apartheid system of fascist exploitation, under the protection of the increasingly overt support of one particular great Power, the Sanctions Conference must do everything possible to give practical expression to the international repudiation of apartheid in the interest of freedom, justice and the right to self-determination in Africa and throughout the world."

I should be grateful if you would kindly arrange to have the above text circulated as an official document of the General Assembly under item 32 of the preliminary list.
