NOTE VERBALE DATED 17 JUNE 1996 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF INDIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. The Permanent Representative of India to the United Nations in New York presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to communication No. SCA/2/96 (10-1) dated 15 May 1996, in which a response regarding implementation of provisions of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) of 26 April 1996 was requested.
2. The Government of India has taken note of the resolution, for compliance as relevant.
3. As regards paragraph 3 (a) of the resolution, the Sudanese authorities have been requested to reduce the strength of their only diplomatic Mission in India by recalling one of the five diplomatic staff of their Embassy in New Delhi by 25 June 1996, which is the last date for giving effect to the provisions set out in paragraph 3, in accordance with paragraph 6 of the resolution.
4. Furthermore, the Sudanese authorities have been advised that all their remaining staff would require prior permission of the Government of India, giving 15 days' advance notice, for their travel in India beyond 60 kilometres from New Delhi.
5. As regards paragraph 3 (b) of the resolution, its provisions have been taken note of for compliance as appropriate.
6. This communication is addressed in response to the request in paragraph 6 of the resolution.
