LETTER DATED 21 JUNE 1996 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF SLOVAKIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I am referring to your note of 15 May 1996 concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996), adopted by the Council at its 3660th meeting, held on 26 April 1996.

I have the honour to inform you that the Slovak Republic and the Sudan have no diplomatic missions or consular posts in their respective territories, so the provision of paragraph 3 (a) of resolution 1054 (1996) is not applicable. Furthermore, the Slovak competent authorities have taken all necessary measures to restrict the entry into and transit through the territory of the Slovak Republic of members of the Government of the Sudan, officials of that Government and members of the Sudanese armed forces.

I should be grateful if you would have this note circulated as a document of the Security Council.
