ANNEX

Telegram dated 27 June 1981 from Mr. Hun Sen addressed
to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that on 1 May 1981, in pursuance of the decree-law concerning elections to the National Assembly of the People's Republic of Kampuchea, the entire Kampuchean people participated en masse in the legislative elections and thereby chose the 117 members of the National Assembly.

The National Assembly of the PRK (first legislature) held its first session from 24 to 27 June 1981 at Phnom Penh. It discussed and adopted the constitution of the PRK, and established the leading institutions of the State, namely, the officers of the National Assembly and the members of the Council of State and of the Council of Ministers.

The leading organs of the PRK elected by the National Assembly are the sole authentic and legal representative of the Kampuchean people. The Pol Pot-Ieng Sary-Khieu Samphan clique, convicted of the crime of genocide, have no right to represent the Kampuchean people in the United Nations or any other international organization.

I request you to distribute the appeal of the National Assembly of Kampuchea and the list of the officers of the National Assembly and members of the Council of State and the Council of Ministers to all member countries of the United Nations and to regard them as official documents of the United Nations.
