LETTER DATED 25 JUNE 1996 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF ARGENTINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to report to you, in accordance with paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 1054 (1996) adopted on 26 April 1996, on the steps taken by the Argentine Republic to give effect to that resolution.

The Government of the Argentine Republic, with a view to implementing the provisions of paragraph 3 (b) of resolution 1054 (1996), has taken the necessary steps to restrict the entry into and the transit through its territory of members of the Government of the Sudan, officials of that Government and members of the Sudanese armed forces.

Since the Argentine Republic has no diplomatic representation in the Sudan and the latter country has no embassy in the Argentine Republic, the provisions of paragraph 3 (a) of resolution 1054 (1996) are not applicable.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter distributed as a document of the Security Council.
